Score Report Naming Convention

Each data file name will be of the form: rmixxxfyyyymmdd.ext, where:

- "r" indicates a file in the Score Reporting System
- "mi" indicates the Michigan Test for Teacher Certification program
- "xxx" indicates the three digit code for your institution
- "f" indicates the content of the file:
 - "r" for score report
 - "e" for ascii examinee data file
 - "s" for ascii summary data file
 - "u" for ascii add-on examinee data file
- "yyyymmdd" is the date of the administration: year/month/day
- "ext" indicates the file extensions:
 - "pdf" for portable document format
 - "asc" for ASCII format
 - "txt" for readable Text format

The information contained herein is confidential and must not be disclosed to unauthorized persons. Appropriate safeguards must be implemented by all personnel to protect examinees from improper disclosure of information.

Individual examinee results are confidential and are for the purpose of Michigan teacher certification only. They are NOT intended to be used for employment decisions, college admission screening, or any other purpose.

Starting with the October 2001 test administration, the flag in column 173 indicates eligibility status. The flag indicates that although the student has requested that scores be sent to this institution, the student DID NOT indicate that she/he is currently attending this institution, or that the student was designated as not meeting the eligibility criteria during the verification process.

Starting with the October 2003 test administration, added academic major/minor and teaching grade level to the student data records and increased record length to 182.

Starting with the October 2007 test administration, test code has been increased to three-digits. All subsequent record layout positions has changed by one position accordingly. Total record length has increased to 183.

Revision Note:

Starting with the October 2008 test administration, scaled scores are reported only for examinees who do not meet the passing score.

Starting with the October 2013 test administration, examinee roster and summary reports and data files were modified to allow reporting of data for up to 15 subareas. In addition, the examinee roster file was modified to include up to 10 analytic category designations, accommodating 5 designations for each of the two PRE Writing subtest constructed-response items (or one set of 7 categories where results are provided for the previous Basic Skills: Writing test).

The .ASC files contain two data files from a single administration of the MTTC program:

- rmixxxeyyyymmdd.asc = Examinee roster from the mm/dd/yy administration. The file contains one record for each test administered (in the case of PRE/Basic Skills, prior attempts are also listed). The file is sorted by Examinee name, Social Security Number (in case of duplicate names), test code, and test date (for PRE/Basic Skills). Each record is 205 characters in length.
- (2) rmixxxsyyyymmdd.asc = Summary data for the institution from the mm/dd/yy administration. This file contains one record for each test taken by at least one eligible examinee from the institution. Each record is 123 characters in length.

Starting with the October 1993 test administration, a new file is included in the .ASC files when appropriate.

NOT EVERY INSTITUTION WILL RECEIVE THIS FILE.

(3) rmixxxuyyyymmdd.asc = Add-on file for the current administration, mm/dd/yy. This file contains one record for each student who was scored or whose scores have been updated since the last scoring period. The file is sorted by examinee name, Social Security Number (in case of duplicate names), test code, and test date. Each record is 205 characters in length. The record layout is the same as the examinee roster record layout.

Record layouts for each of the above files appear below. Note that the records are fixed length as a result of allowing for 15 test subareas for each test.

If the test form had fewer than 15 subareas, the "extra" subarea scores or means will be blank.
